Transition: Pathway to the Future — Using the IEP to Develop Transition Services

Transition planning is an important step in preparing your student with a disability for life after high school. Participants at this workshop will learn how to help students achieve their dreams and goals.

Topics will include:

- Evaluating your child's educational needs related to transition
- Identifying required transition areas for planning, including post-secondary education and training, employment, and independent living
- Recognizing people inside and outside the school community who can support your child's transition planning
- Knowing what transition services on your child's IEP may include
- Understanding age of majority and transfer of rights to the student
- Learning about adult services

The Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) requires schools to invite the child with a disability to attend the IEP team meeting when transition planning or postsecondary goals will be discussed. Is your child prepared to attend that meeting?

This workshop will help students with IEPs and their parents understand how to use the Individualized Education Program (IEP) to assist with the transition to adulthood. Presenters will use the PACER booklet, "Guide for Minnesota Parent to the IEP" to help participants understand how each required part of the IEP can be developed to meet the student's needs and move them in the direction of their hopes and dreams.

Students should be able to participate in a computer based activity.
